Every day, university ethics committees face new challenges in the application of technology in research due to the numerous changes induced by data-driven solutions in various scientific areas. In their role, ethics committees are often required to find new solutions to balance competing interests. To achieve this goal, their composition, relations with the university bodies and community, as well as internal organisation are crucial.

In the context of the Jean Monnet Chair in Mediterranean Digital Societies and Law, the workshop aims to facilitate an international exchange of experiences among ethics committees operating in the Mediterranean region. The focus will be on the following main topics: (i) critical and emerging issues in research and ethics; (ii) the role of the ECs in the university organisation; (iii) competences of the ECs; (iv) composition, methodologies, deliberative models and tools.

The discussion will take place under the Chatham House rule (no views or positions may be attributed publicly to any participant) and will be based on a round table discussion to which all participants will contribute on the basis of their experience, including the presentation of some cases related to the key points listed above.
